HEAR THE DIFFERENCES

Aim: Give Ss practice listening for differences between a conversation

they read and a conversation they hear.

Preparation: Make one copy of the worksheet for every two Ss. Cut the copies in half. Have available the audio program for the

Conversation on page 89.

Comment: Use before the Conversation on page 89. Use the audio

program for the Conversation.

■ Books closed. Give each S a worksheet. Ss read the conversation silently.

- Explain the task. Ss listen to the audio program for the Conversation on page 89 and find the differences between the dialog on the audio program and the one on the worksheet. When they hear a difference, they circle and correct it.
- Play the audio program three times. The first time, Ss circle the differences. The second time, they correct them. The third time, they check their corrections.
- Books open. Ss read the Conversation to check their answers.

Answers
