The Grand Canyon includes around 70 species of mammals, 250 species of birds, and 25 types of reptiles.




Aurora Borealis (The Northern Lights)

1.42 x 2.12 meters

A colourful light display in the sky that can be seen at night. Oxygen makes a yellowgreen colour, Nitrogen causes a red display, and Helium makes blue-purple colours.

The lights also produce a strange sound for those close enough to hear, similar to the sound of applause!



Mount Everest

Location The Himalayas, border of Nepal and Tibet, China.

Size 8848 meters high

Description

The highest mountain in the world. Scientists believe it was formed by water, ice and wind over millions of years. The temperature at the summit never rises above freezing!

MORE! fact

Every year the mountain grows taller by 4mm from the upward thrust of two opposing tectonic plates.

Paricutin Volcano

Mexico



Location Brazil

Size 20 miles long (inland)

Description

The world's largest natural deep-water bay that was created by the Atlantic Ocean. The ocean waves eroded the softer rocks and sand of the bay, leaving the hard surrounding rocks still intact.

MORE! fact

The harbor looks different from different angles – it resembles the mouth of a large river or lake depending on where you stand.

Africa Description


Victoria Falls is known as the 'greatest falling curtain of water in the world'. A beautiful rainbow appears over Victoria Falls at night as the moon light hits the water.


MORE! fact
