PRONUNCIATION MAZE

Aim: Give Ss practice identifying endings pronounced / 1z /. *Preparation:* Make one copy of the worksheet for every two Ss. *Comment:* Use after the Pronunciation on page 38.

- Ss work in pairs. Give each pair a maze.
- Explain any new vocabulary (e.g., *kisses, washes*) and review any other vocabulary Ss have questions about (e.g., *chooses, compares, guesses, matches*).
- Explain the task. Ss begin at Start and go through the maze. Whenever they go through a door, they circle the verb. However, they can only go through doors where the pronunciation of the verb's *-s* ending is / 1z/. Ask: "What doors can I go through first?" (Answer: *guesses, exercises*, or *fixes*)
- The first S to exit the maze wins.

- Ss complete the task in pairs. Go around the class and encourage Ss to say the words aloud.
- Check the answers with the class.
