SCRAMBLED DIALOG

Aim: Familiarize Ss with an audio script before they listen to it.
Preparation: Make one copy of the worksheet for every two Ss. Cut the copies into strips and put them in envelopes. Have available the audio program for the Conversation on page 75.
Comment: Use before or after the Conversation on page 75. Use the audio program for the Conversation.

- Ss work in pairs. Give each pair an envelope with the strips.
- Set the scene and explain the task. Two friends are talking about Mexico City. Ss arrange the strips to form the conversation. Ask: "What is the first sentence?" (Answer: *Can you tell me a little about Mexico City*?)
- Ss complete the task in pairs.
- Play the audio program. Ss listen and check the order of their conversations.
- **Option:** After they listen to the audio program, Ss practice the conversation using information about a different city.

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Can you tell me a little about Mexico City?
OK. It's on my list now! Anything else?
Oh, you should definitely visit the Museum of Anthropology. It's amazing.
Well, I'm going to be there for a few days next month. What should I do there?
You shouldn't miss the Palace of Fine Arts. It's really beautiful.
