## **ERROR CORRECTION**

collaboratively.

Preparation: Make one copy of the worksheet for every two Ss. Cut the

copies in half.

Comment: Use after the Grammar Focus on page 20.

- Give half the class Worksheet A and half Worksheet B. Explain that six sentences on each worksheet have grammar mistakes.
- Explain the task.
- Individually, Ss write *C* if the sentence is correct and *I* if it is incorrect.
- Ss work in pairs, one A with one B. They compare sentences and decide which one is correct. (For each sentence, one S has the correct sentence.)
- Go over the answers with the class.
