YOU CHOOSE!

Aim: Give Ss practice with would rather and would prefer in a speaking activity. *Preparation:* Make one copy of the worksheet for every four Ss. Cut each page into four cards.

Comment: Use after or in place of the Role Play on page 52.

- Ss work in groups of four. Give each S in a group one card (A, B, C, or D). Point out that they cannot look at each other's card.
- Write on the board:
 Would you rather ...?
 Would you prefer ...?
- Set the scene: Ss have the opportunity to study English abroad and have several programs to choose from.
- Model the task with the card for Student A. Read the descriptions. Ask: "Would you rather study in London, Kingston, or Perth?" Elicit answers from a few Ss. Encourage them to use *I'd rather* or *I'd prefer to*.
- Ss complete the task. Each S reads the options on the card to the other Ss in the group. Ss answer, giving their preferences and reasons.
