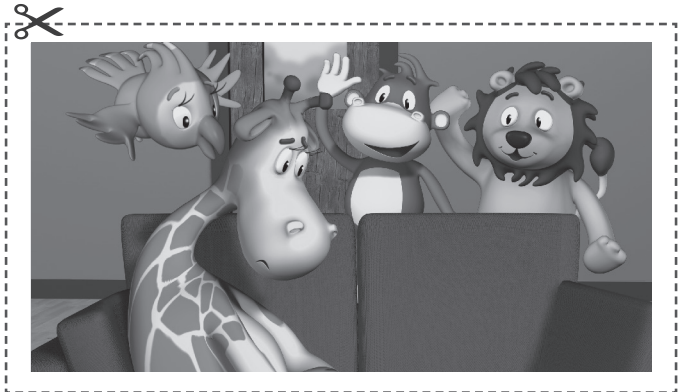
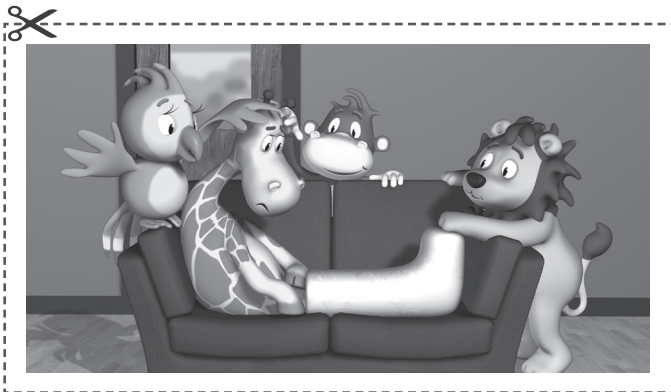
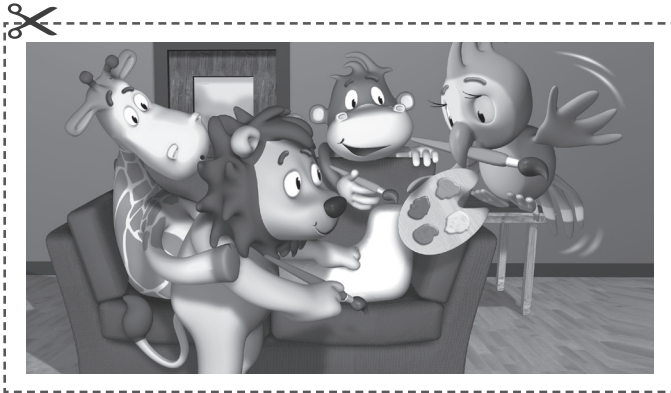

*Cut out the five pictures on worksheet part 1. Point to the characters. Your child says the names. Ask what is happening in the story (the child tries to remember and explain in his/her own language). Read the story script and help the child put the pictures in the correct order. Check with Student's Book pages 20 and 21.*

*Give the child glue and the second part of the worksheet. He/She sticks the pictures down in order into the blank frames. When he/she has finished, talk about what is happening in the story again (Gina has broken her leg and is sad. The other animals use different colors to paint her plaster cast and cheer her up.). The child can then color the pictures.*
