Disadvantages: can be sad when patients are sick, might have to work long hours

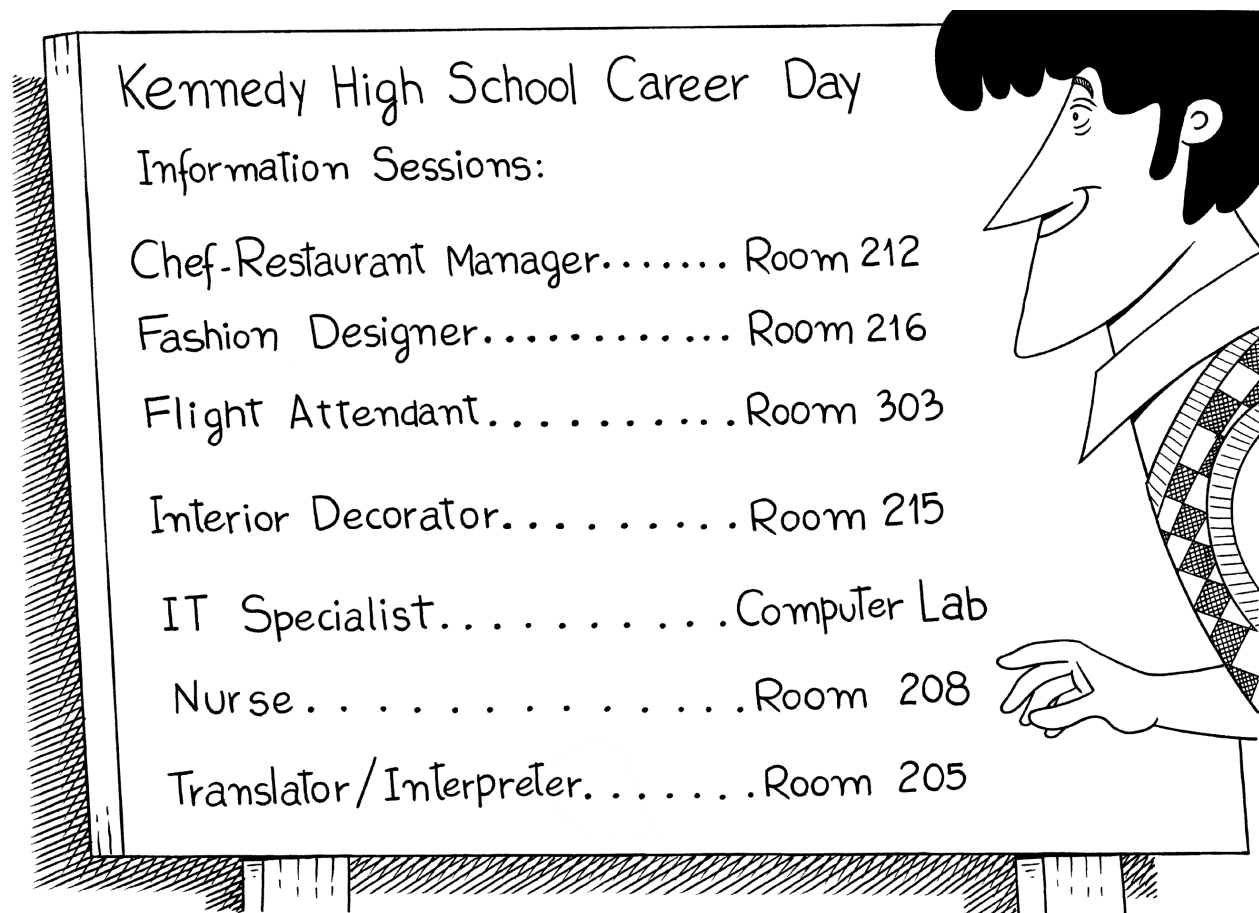
#### Translator/Interpreter
