Time

20 minutes

Preparation

Duplicate one Student A page and one Student B page for each pair.

Procedure

- 1. Tell students they are going to practice asking about people's lives and experiences. Put students in pairs and distribute worksheets. In each pair, one student receives the Student A worksheet and the other the Student B worksheet. Tell students that they should not look at their partner's worksheet.
- 2. Model the activity by pointing to the picture of Tom Jacobs and asking: *How long has Tom been married?* Elicit the answer from Students B (*He's been married for five years.*). Have Students A write *for five years* on the blank in their sheets.
- 3. Have pairs continue asking and answering about the people in the pictures. Point out different kinds of information are missing from some of the blanks. Elicit examples of other questions with the present perfect and *for / since*, such as *Where has he lived since 2007? What has Marco loved since he was kid?*

- 4. As students are working, walk around to monitor the activity and help as needed. Make sure students are actually asking questions and not just copying the information from the sheets. Make note of any errors or problems to review later.
- 5. When pairs are finished, have them compare worksheets and correct any differences. **Note:** For each blank on one worksheet, students will find the correct information on the other sheet.
