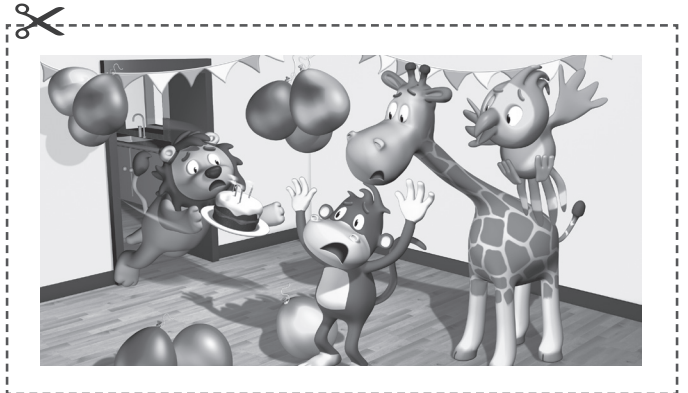


7 Story worksheet: The cake

Unit 7 Story: Guidelines for parents and guardians

Dad: Here's your cake.
 Leo: Thank you, Dad. I like cake.

All: Oh, no!

Leo: My cake ...
 All: Ohhh ...

Gina: I have an idea.
 Polly: What is it?
 Gina: Let's get some ice cream.
 Mike: Lovely idea!

Leo: I like ice cream.
 Mike: Yes, it's great.
 Gina: Wonderful!
 Polly: Yummy!

Cut out the five pictures on worksheet part 1. Point to the characters. Your child says the names (encourage him/her to say cake, too). Ask what is happening in the story (the child tries to remember and explain in his/her own language). Read the story script and help the child put the pictures in the correct order. Check with Student's Book pages 60 and 61.

Give the child glue and the second part of the worksheet. He/She sticks the pictures down in order into the blank frames. When he/she has finished, talk about what is happening in the story again (It's Leo's birthday party and his dad gives him a cake. Leo falls over and the cake falls on his head. The other animals help clean up and get some ice cream instead.). The child can then color the pictures.
