Unit 6 Story: Guidelines for parents and guardians

Leo: Look. The cat! The cat!

Cut out the five pictures on worksheet part 1. Point to the characters. Your child says the names (encourage him/her to say cat, too). Ask what is happening in the story (the child tries to remember and explain in his/her own language). Read the story script and help the child put the pictures in the correct order. Check with Student's Book pages 52 and 53.

Give the child glue and the second part of the worksheet. He/She sticks the pictures down in order into the blank frames. When he/she has finished, talk about what is happening in the story again (The animals see a cat stuck in a tree. They work together to reach the cat and help it down.). The child can then color the pictures.
