





The present continuous is: am/is/are + doing/eating/running/writing etc.

Ι am (not) he she is (not) -ing it we you are (not)

- □ I'm working. I'm not watching TV.
- ☐ Maria **is reading** a newspaper.
- ☐ She **isn't eating**. (or She's **not** eat**ing**.)
- □ The phone **is ringing**.
- □ We're having dinner.
- ☐ You're not listening to me. (or You aren't listening ...)
- ☐ The children **are doing** their homework.

am/is/are + **-ing** = something is happening *now*:

I'm working she's wearing a hat they're playing football I'm not watching television

future □ Please be quiet. I'm working. (= I'm working now)

- □ Look, there's Sarah. She's wearing a brown coat. (= she is wearing it now)

- □ 'Where are the children?' 'They're playing in the park.'

he works / she lives / it rains etc.
