Holmes then continues his investigations alone. He later calls ¹² and arranges to meet him at a restaurant in Kensington. That evening, Holmes and Watson break into the house of ¹³ , where they find a window overlooking the Underground line. Holmes puts a message in the newspaper, hoping Cadogan West's killer will see it. Holmes waits in ¹⁴ 's house with ¹⁵ , ¹⁶ and ¹⁷ for the thief and killer to arrive. After a while ¹⁸ arrives. He has stolen the papers, but ¹⁹ killed Cadogan West.
