



Unit 4 Story: Guidelines for parents and guardians

Cut out the five pictures on worksheet part 1. Point to the characters and the toys. Your child says the names and the words. Ask what is happening in the story (the child tries to remember and explain in his/her own language). Read the story script and help the child put the pictures in the correct order. Check with Student's Book pages 36 and 37.

Give the child glue and the second part of the worksheet. He/She sticks the pictures down in order into the blank frames. When he/she has finished, talk about what is happening in the story again (Leo has lost the last piece of his puzzle. The other animals help him to look for it. Then they find it on the end of his tail!). The child can then color the pictures.
