

Ask questions about the picture, e.g., Can you see a hat? Can you see pencils? Can you see a teacher? Can you see pants? Can you see a firefighter? Can you see paper? Your child points. He/She can also ask you questions. Ask the child if he/she knows the names of other jobs in English (farmer, police officer, builder, doctor).

Play the song. The child sings and points to the correct person in the picture. Give the child crayons to color the picture in. When he/she has finished, ask about different items, e.g., What color is the hat? What color are her pants? You can also make sentences with I have ... , e.g., I have paper. / I have a hat. The child says Teacher or Firefighter.
