Unit 7 Story: Guidelines for parents and guardians

Leo: Let's play firefighters!
 Gina: OK. You're a firefighter. I'm a firefighter.
 Leo: Look, a fire! Let's go!

Gina: Oh, no! Help!

Leo and Gina: Help!
 Mike and Polly: Oh, no!

Polly: I can help!
 Mike: Yay!

Mike: Good job, Polly!
 Leo and Gina: Thank you, Polly!

Cut out the five pictures on worksheet part 1. Point to the characters. Your child says the names (encourage him/her to say what job the animals are playing: firefighter). Ask what is happening in the story (the child tries to remember and explain in his/her own language). Read the story script and help the child put the pictures in the correct order. Check with Student's Book pages 60 and 61.

Give the child glue and the second part of the worksheet. He/She sticks the pictures down in order into the blank frames. When he/she has finished, talk about what is happening in the story again (Gina and Leo are playing at being firefighters. They climb up a ladder to a tree house, but the ladder breaks. Polly and Mike have to help them and rescue them for real.). The child can then color the pictures.
