

Unit 5 Song: Guidelines for parents and guardians

Do you like vegetables?

Yes, I do.

I have a vegetable pie for you.

Potatoes, carrots ... and peas

Do you like fruit?

Yes, I do.

How about you?

Ask your child the following questions about food: Do you like vegetables? (Yes, I do. / No, I don't.) Is a carrot a vegetable? (Yes, it is.) What color is it? (Orange.) Is a watermelon a vegetable? (No, it isn't.) Encourage the child to say It's a fruit. What color is it? (It's green and red.) Is it big or small? (It's big.) Ask similar questions about potatoes, peas, bananas, and strawberries.

Point to the fruit in the picture and ask Vegetables or fruit? (Fruit.) Say Point to the vegetable pie (the child points). You can also revise mom, dad, brother, and sister (e.g., Point to Mom.). Play the song. Encourage your child to join in and point to the pie and the fruit in the picture. Give the child crayons to color the picture. When he/she has finished, point and ask about the color of the different clothes/items of food.
