## Unit 7 Grammar: Guidelines for parents and guardians

*Help your child to cut out the cards (with child-safe scissors). Your child says the words (carrots, sausages, apples, cakes, ice cream, fries). You can play different games. Or use a set of twelve cards to play a game of pairs (place the cards face down and try to turn over a pair, saying a sentence with like or don't like each time, e.g., I like ice cream).
