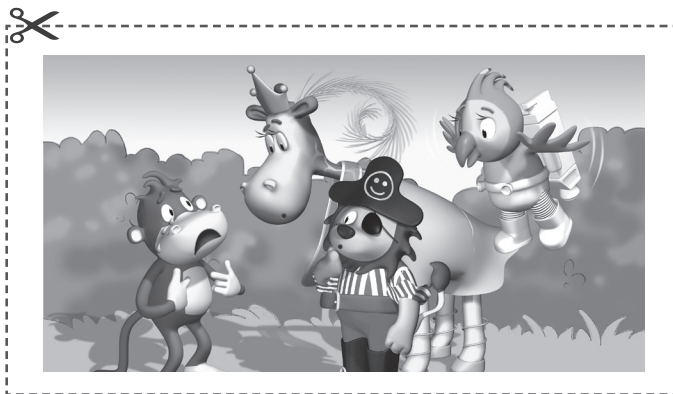
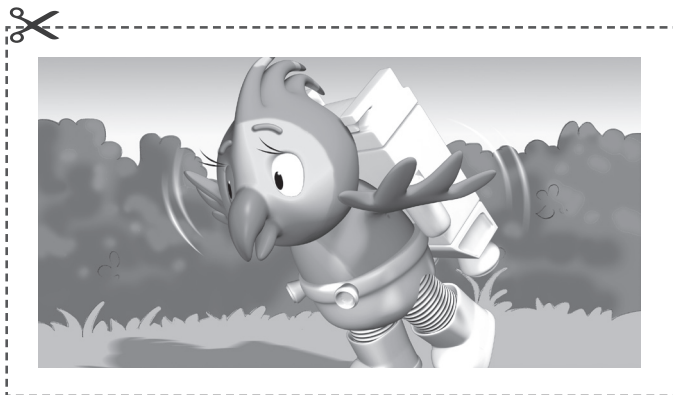

## Unit 8 Story: Guidelines for parents and guardians

Gina: Look! I like my dress and my shoes!

Leo: Look! I like my hat and my pants!

Polly: Look! I like my pants and my shoes!

Mike: Look ... I like ...

Gina, Polly,  
and Leo: Oh, no! Don't worry. We can help.

Leo: Wow!

Gina: I like your pants, your hat, and your shoes!

*Cut out the five pictures on worksheet part 1. Point to the characters. Your child says the names (encourage him/her to say pants, dress, hat, and shoes, too). Ask what is happening in the story (the child tries to remember and explain in his/her own language). Read the story script and help the child put the pictures in the correct order. Check with Student's Book pages 68 and 69.*

*Give the child glue and the second part of the worksheet. He/She sticks the pictures down in order into the blank frames. When he/she has finished, talk about what is happening in the story again (Gina, Leo, and Polly are ready to go to a costume party and are talking about their clothes. Mike is sad because he doesn't have a costume. The other animals give Mike different items of clothing from their costumes to make an outfit.). The child can then color the pictures.*
