

THE GRANITE TEMPLE OF KHAFA, AT GIZEH

This temple is connected by a causeway $\pm$ of a mile long, with the temple of similar construction in front of the Second Pyramid. The interior here is all of polished granite, beside some alabaster in a few parts; the body of the masonry is of megalithic blocks of limestone, and the outer face of the pile was decorated by a pattern of cross-grooves. The halls and passages were roofed over, with an open-air court on the top of the building.
