Figure A12.1 Most similar words to liberal, 1720–1960




Figure A12.2 Most similar words to liberty, 1720–1960



Figure A12.3 Historical-semantic distance matrix for station, 1720–1960




Figure A12.4 Superimposed historical-semantic distance matrices for all significantly novel words


