WALLS AND BARRACKS AROUND THE SECOND PYRAMID.

Each point here entered is fixed by recent excavations and survey; the corners of the cap of casing were triangulated, and the edge filled in from photographs. The barracks are suitable for 3600 men; the Northern galleries were cleared in parts, and nearly all the wall-faces measured; the Western galleries were found uniform in each part cleared, and the middles of nearly all the walls measured. The most perfect galleries are still about 7 feet high, each with fine stone terminal.
