Useful resources for evaluating BLL courses:

- Quality Matters (QM) is a nationally recognized, faculty-driven peer review process used to ensure the quality of online and blended course design, provides a set of standards used to evaluate the design of online and blended courses. These standards were developed and revised based on research and established standards in the fields of instructional design and online learning.
- Bowyer and Chambers (2017) provide an excellent overview of different frameworks that have been proposed for the evaluation of BL in general. The authors propose their own framework, from which we have drawn inspiration.
- Van den Branden (2006) and his colleagues at the Center for Language Education at the Katholieke Universiteit Leuven in Belgium provide an example of full program evaluation of TBLT curricula.
